## How to Gain Institutional Access to the *All of Us* Dataset



Only researchers whose institutions have signed a **Data Use and Registration Agreement (DURA)** and who have verified their identity may access the *All of Us* Researcher Workbench's Registered and Controlled Tiers. Currently, academic, not-for-profit, and health care organizations can enter into a DURA, which must be signed by an institutional signing official.

### The Data Use and Registration Agreement (DURA) Process



**\*Researcher tip:** You will need to provide the name of a signing official at your institution.

### 3 Categories of Agreements

- R** 1. Institutional agreements that grant all registered researchers access to the **Registered Tier only**, with no Controlled Tier access.
- R C** 2. Institutional agreements that grant all registered researchers access to **both the Registered and Controlled Tiers**. *Some agreements may require additional approval for the Controlled Tier.*
- i** 3. **Individual data-use agreements required** for any institutional researcher seeking access to the Registered or Controlled Tier.

**Key:** ● Registered Tier    ● Controlled Tier    ● Individual agreements required by institution
