Dr. Diana Gehlhaus is a Director for Economy at the Special Competitive Studies Project. She is also an adjunct policy researcher at the RAND Corporation. Diana was previously a senior advisor in the U.S. Department of Defense Chief Digital and Artificial Intelligence Office (DoD CDAO), where she stood up a division dedicated to identifying, cultivating, and growing the Department's data, analytics, and AI workforce. Prior to the DoD, Diana was a research fellow at Georgetown University's Center for Security and Emerging Technology (CSET), where she designed and led CSET's line of research on the AI workforce in the U.S. and China. Diana has also served as an economist at the Progressive Policy Institute, and in government at the Export-Import Bank and Bureau of Labor Statistics. Diana holds a PhD in policy analysis from the Pardee RAND Graduate School, a Master's degree in applied economics from Johns Hopkins University, and studied mathematics and economics at Bucknell University.
