Charles Branas is the Gelman Endowed Professor of Epidemiology and Chair of the Department of Epidemiology at Columbia University. Dr. Branas has conducted research that extends from urban and rural areas in the United States to communities across the globe, incorporating place-based interventions and human geography. His work on public safety, access to medical care, and disaster response has led to medical system changes, a series of national scientific replications in the United States and other countries, and citations in U.S. Supreme Court decisions and Congress. With community partners, Dr. Branas led the first city-wide randomized controlled trials of place-based solutions for improving health and safety. He has worked internationally on four continents and led multi-national efforts, producing extensive cohorts of scientists, national health metrics, and worldwide press coverage. Dr. Branas is a member of the National Academy of Medicine and the American Epidemiological Society.
