Chris Frey is the Senate-confirmed Assistant Administrator for Research and Development at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). He also serves as the Agency Science Advisor. Dr. Frey joined the Agency in February, 2021, as an appointee of the Biden-Harris Administration. An engineer by training, Dr. Frey was the Glenn E. and Phyllis J. Futrell Distinguished University Professor at North Carolina State University prior to joining the EPA, where he served on the faculty since 1994. His research includes measurement and modeling of human exposure to air pollution, measurement and modeling of vehicle emissions, and applications of probabilistic and sensitivity analysis methods to emissions estimation, risk assessment, and technology assessment.
