Jeanne Herb is Director of the Environmental Analysis and Communications Group, a center of service, applied research and practice at the Rutgers University Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy. Jeanne leads applied research and collaborative strategies at the intersection of social and environmental determinants of health, environmental sustainability and climate change, state and local public policy, and inclusive, participatory decision-making. She Co-Directs the state's Climate Change Resource Center, a statutorily established and academically housed service center providing support to communities, state and local decision-makers and the private sector to advance equitable and science-informed climate change solutions. Prior to joining Rutgers in 2010, Jeanne spent more than two decades at the state Department of Environmental Protection, most recently as the Assistant Commissioner of Policy, Planning and Science where she oversaw multidisciplinary programs related to environmental health, sustainable development, Environmental Justice, climate change and coastal management. In-between two tenures in state government, she managed the public policy program at the Boston-based, nonprofit "think-do" tank, Tellus Institute, where she provided support to states in implementing innovative environmental policies. She participated in the first cohort of the 3-year Robert Wood Johnson Foundation *Culture of Health Leaders Program* and the 2-year *Rutgers Leadership Academy*. Jeanne is currently leading a National Academy of Sciences workshop planning committee on the topic of communities, climate change and health equity. She is a 1981 alumnus of Rutgers University and has a Master's degree in Science, Health and Environmental Journalism from New York University. Jeanne is an adjunct member of the Bloustein faculty, a New Jersey native and mom to two amazing adult daughters.
